On the release of their latest single, "No Limit," the lyrics deliver the message that there is no limit when we surrender everything over to God. We can't know the future, but He does.

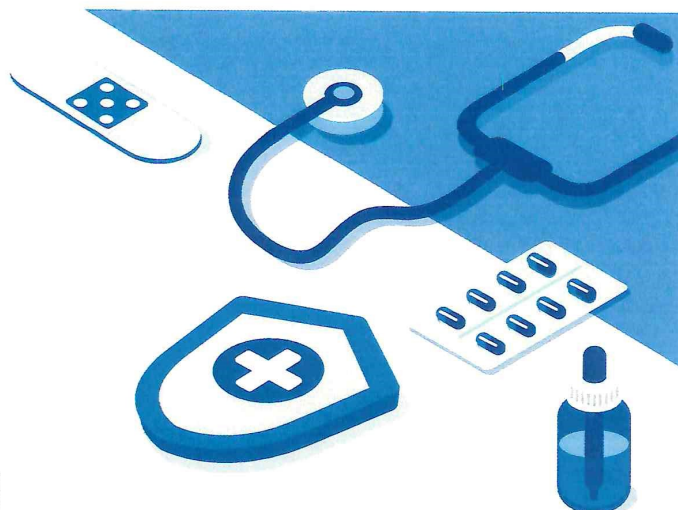
